TREASURERS REPORT Marc Peskett

The 2017 year has seen the club continue to build on its sound financial base. Overall the club finished the year above budget of the back of



increased revenue which was up by 15%. Sponsorship was up by \$13,000, with the Club 74 initiative contributing \$7,000. Summer hockey was also a great success with registrations increasing.

The club's major assets are the ground, property improvements and cash reserves. We have no external debt and our only liabilities are normal trade creditors and current payroll and GST liabilities.

With cash management, our key objective is to ensure we have enough funds reserved to cover the replacement of the pitch, other major maintenance items as they arise and to allow for contingencies and other abnormal operational expenses.

In October, the club, with the Manningham City Council went through to a tender process to appoint a contractor for the replacement of the pitch. As a result of that process Polytan was appointed and the pitch replacement started in December 2017. The club's contribution to the pitch replacement is capped at \$326,000, which we have in cash reserves set aside for this purpose.

We have a small reserved amount set aside to meet operational contingencies and other maintenance items as they arise. We also need to take account that we now have a mini pitch that will need maintenance and refurbishment in the future.

The club will continue with it's strategic decision to reinvest its profits into Coaching and development and improving infrastructure for players, coaches and members. This investment is only made after the playing sections have contributed to the ground management reserve by paying ground hire fees for the use of the pitch.

Respectful Relationships, Mental Health and Resilience workshops



As part of our 2016-2017 Youth Leadership and Development Program which is funded by Bendigo Banks Community Enterprise Foundation, we are proud to deliver several successful workshops.



The *iMatter-Respectful* relationships workshop was facilitated by Doncare 30

workshop was facilitated by <u>Doncare</u>. 30 of our young players attended the night and participated in interactive discussions. This Workshop was one of the key activities being delivered, as part of the *Manningham Safe*, *Respectful and Inclusive Sporting Club Project*, which our club is participating in. In addition to the workshop a DHC sub-committee made up of representatives from across the club met with City of Manningham to raise awareness, assist us with tools and recommendations on

promoting gender equality and strive to prevent violence against women in our community. Thank you to Jessmay Cameron, Callum Storey, Nicola Clutton, Fran Wood and Deb Ballment for their involvement.

In late July, we hosted **Outside the Locker Room** conducted by Jake Edwards former AFL footballer. Jake tells a powerful story of his own journey with depression, anxiety and addiction. He tells of proactive strategies of how to deal with mental health and how to support people with mental health issues. 50 people attended being a mixture of men and women, senior and junior players and parents. The session was excellent and well received by participants.


KE40 (pronounced key-40)

WOMEN AND GIRLS @Doncaster- Meridie Jackson

The executive team has made a concerted effort this year to understand why there is a significant drop out rates of girls playing sport and hockey in their middle teenage years. In all sports, almost half as many 16-24 year-old women take part in sport as men of the same age, and it is no different at Doncaster. A positive

however was that in 2017, Doncaster Hockey Club was one of only 2 clubs to have 3 all girls Under 12 teams.

Our goal is to continue to increase the number of girls playing and improve the retention rate by working towards maintaining their connection with their team mates and our club. To achieve this, a review paper was put together which identified the following factors for our club to implement:

- Ensure that women are encouraged and have the opportunity to undertake leadership positions including in coaching, officiating, and committee membership ie. Give women a strong voice in the club
- Quality coaches in the critical age group who deliver a style of coaching that is suitable to this age group including use of positive, encouraging and instructional feedback
- Promote a positive group atmosphere within teams and club
- Regularly review reasons why girls stop hockey, to be able to identify trends through exit surveys and other feedback mechanisms
- Ensure that the training and competition needs of elite female athletes are identified and addressed
- Promote beginner and intermediate activities for girls and women as fun, open and noncompetitive
- Encourage/set up club social media to connect girls away from hockey
- Provide support to juniors transitioning to seniors eg. mentoring, individual feedback sessions from coaches, support to balance competing priorities
- Women and girls are more open to ideas about 'health' and 'well-being' than sport so combine physical activity with health activities- eg. have experts with a focus on health and sport come to speak to girls
- Provide more social time to encourage connectedness

NB: DHC played a key role in the Hockey Victoria girls participation video released in November 2017 which is now on Youtube <u>https://youtu.be/3SHfD0v_vVo</u> Under 12 girls, parents, female coaches and Premier League women have strong representation in this video.
